In 1998, Scott developed and founded Oasys, an Internet based, "electronic file room" which gives doctors and patients direct access to their medical records and images, and expanded the product to Hospitals.

He currently serves over 3,500 referring doctors and works with multiple regional Hospitals, having done nearly 2 million exams on over 75,000 patients, with all records permanently archived electronically and immediately accessible via our secure, HIPAA compliant website portal.

Since inception in 1996, Scott has been President and CEO of Northeast Radiology and its group of imaging centers. It has grown to an organization with seven locations, over 100 employees, and annual revenues of over \$25M. Over the past 15 years, Scott has been closely involved in supporting three other start-up companies.

In Scott's academic career he has authored or coauthored over 25 peer-reviewed scientific articles and abstracts, and has given numerous lectures and presentations. He was also the recipient and principal investigator in five funded grants.
